- Teaching in Ramallah will occur in Arabic and English (accessible for both English or Arabic speakers)
- Participate in an online reading/reflection forum about narrative responses to trauma (only for English speakers)

Ramallah is a vibrant city; Jerusalem is one of the most extraordinary places in the world; and Palestinian therapists know more than most about responding to individuals, families and groups who have experienced and are still experiencing trauma and social suffering.

This event is being hosted by Dulwich Centre Foundation International and the Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre (TRC). It is the next step in an eight year partnership which has seen the development of the first Arabic speaking narrative therapy teaching and supervision team.
